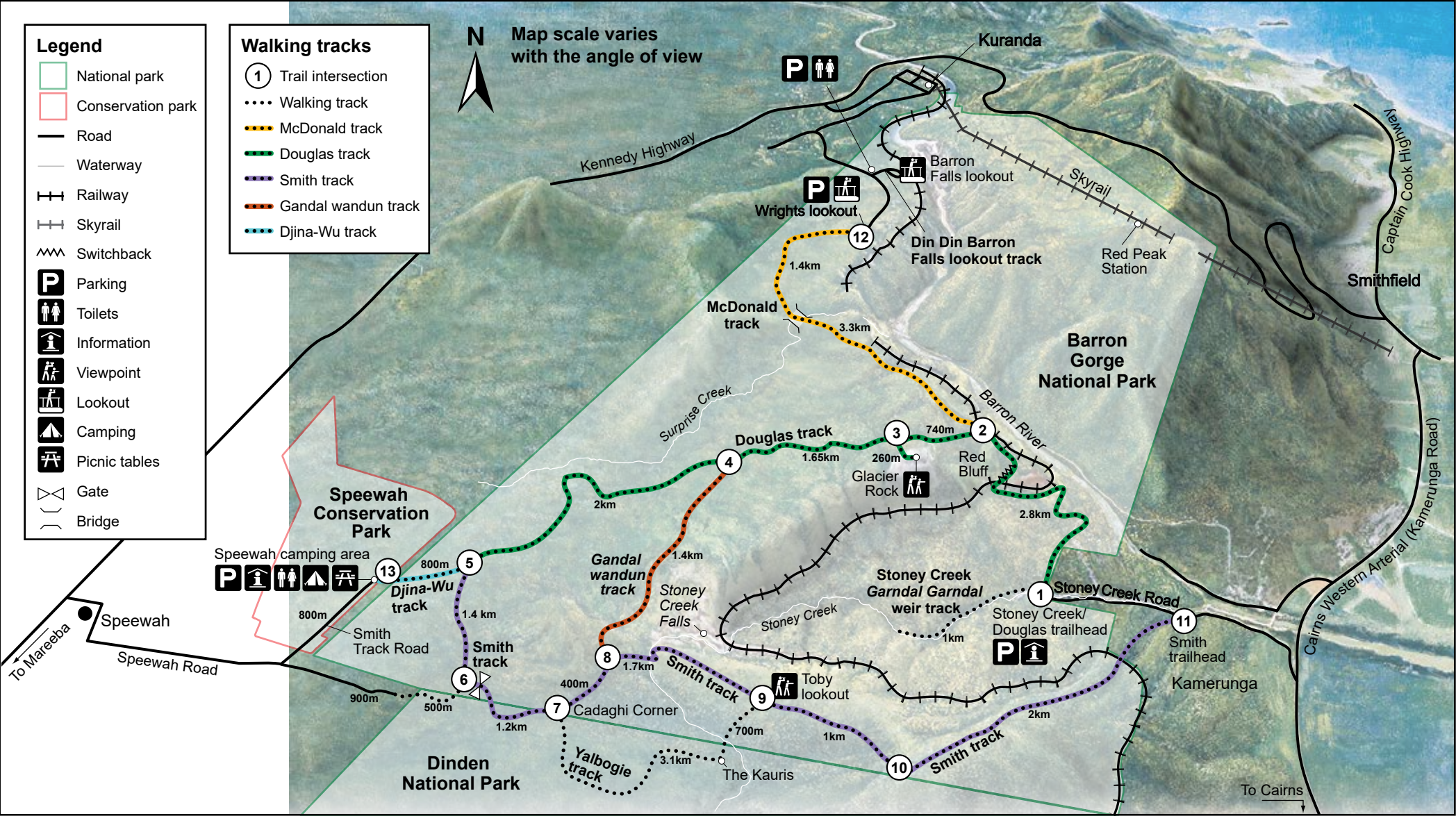

Walk options and suggested walk times

Distances and walking times are measured from the trailhead (one way).

Follow the track colour codings (left to right) to complete each walk.

* Starting Smith track from Kamerunga at the Smith trailhead ⑪ is not recommended unless you are very fit.
If walking Smith track via Yalbogie track, allow an extra 30min.
